....social, economic, and vocations demands which are over their heads result in immature, impulsive, and self-defeating responses.

....the cognitive capacities required to meet the demands of everyday living may be limited.

....thinking is unclear, poorly focused, haphazard, and inaccurate.

....avoids complication, demands requiring a clear precise overview, and the punishing prospects for failure to offer positive solutions.
