

OBJECTIVITY

Synonyms: aloof, impartial, indifferent, impassive

He looks at life objectively and keeps a low degree of personal involvement.

Able to accept constructive criticism, she takes an objective, critical look at herself. She has no difficulty making changes in her behavior or manner of working when necessary.

Taking an objective view of what needs to be done to improve her performance, she handles critical performance reviews without taking negative comments personally.

A strongly emotional nature hinders his ability to remain objective.

Appealing to his sense of logic will draw more favorable response than an emotional entreaty.

Don't expect him to show his emotions readily, nor get too deeply involved in emotional exchanges. He is more comfortable standing back and taking a neutral position.

Even though her deepest prejudices may be involved, this is someone who has the ability to separate herself from the situation and make impartial judgments.

Because he has little need of close personal involvements, he is able to remain detached and observant in the most objective manner.

Uninfluenced by either flattery or censure, she feels quite comfortable taking the middle ground and holding firm to her convictions.

Lacking in sentimentality, his view is an impartial one, whereby he considers only the facts of the matter, putting all emotion aside.

He tends to get so wrapped up in his imagination that he is unable to differentiate the essentials from the fantasy and his views are totally subjective.

He is passionate about everything he does and finds it difficult to remain objective and separate himself when emotions become involved.

She is unable to distance herself emotionally, which impedes her ability to be objective.
