

Perceptual Organization Out of Chaos

"In his inkblot studies Rorschach cognitively allowed the perceptual world to break into fragmentary pieces before reassembling them as a psychodiagnostic technique... While creating the inkblots and exploring the emergence of perceptual organization out of chaos, he allowed his visual reality to crumble into unstructured fragments. He then reassembled his perceptual universe, creating a new psychodiagnostic technique and a new understanding of the perceptual process." (p. 200)
