In 1993, Exner presented statistics on his scoring method, showing it to be such that people normally (NOT exceptionally) trained in its use could do so with reasonable accuracy against a gold standard. Confirming Exner '88, Guarnaccia et al '01 failed to replicate. There is now no evidence that the CS meets minimum requirements for use by anyone, "expert" or not. Burden of proof's on the R proponents! rkm
