Synonyms: obdurate, inflexible, bull-headed, unbending

She can be stubborn and rigid, digging in her heels and becoming loud in her own defense.

Despite her propensity for going with the flow, she can be quite stubborn.

Resisting outside influences, she sometimes clings tenaciously to opinions that have been proven ineffective or even wrong.

He tends to be stubborn and resistant, so any critical performance appraisal needs to be done with tact if he is going to listen and make the effort to change his behavior and tactics.

He could get into some hot water with his belligerent attitude. He likes to have things done his way or not at all.

He can be most stubborn, particularly if he feels his intimate, personal concerns are being intruded upon.

An intense person with strong opinions of his own, he is often tenacious about his decisions and can be biased in his view.
